SBF put efforts and made MCD react as of not having a particular area for garbage dump people little their home garbage waste or their domestic refuse on the road which causes difficulties to the commuter the patient of Al shifa hospital and the students of milli school SBF noticed all these difficulties for all the local citizens and took this initiative to come out and clean with this movement of society for bright future MCD reacted immediately and sent their MCD send their JCB at 11:15 a.m. right after 45 minutes of starting the movement. Which had started at 10:30



Uttarakhand Glacier blast tragedy

8th February 2021, Society for Bright future, ba-hadrabad unit area convener Mohd Shahnwaz with three volunteer visited Risikesh and Haridwar to know the water level and any casualty in these areas because these areas on high alert by the local authorities. On 7th February, SBF Uttarakhand Convener Mr Waseem has communicated with NDRF at Dehradun regarding the ongoing disaster, NDRF restricted entry for civilians. Uttarakhand team of 25 Volunteers were ready and other state volunteers were also ready for emergency relief.



26 bodies had recovered from different areas that were affected by the glacier burst in Chamoli district in Uttarakhand, while 197 people were still missing. Rescue operation at the tunnel were operated. In this connection a SBF team reached near spot and participated in funeral of late Mr. Manoj Choudhary SI Uttarakhand Police, who has lost his life at Tapohan on 7 Feb, during duty hours, SBF team also met his elder brother, Mr. Subodh Chaudhary, console him and his family and present their condolence on this sad demise. SBF offered its further support to his family. Team lead by Mr. Irfan Ahmad, national coordinator, Mr. Waseem Ahmad, Convener, Uttarakhand, Sajid Attar, Convener UP West and Mohd Saquib, Volunteer were the part of team. Team was stayed there for relief work.

State Training workshop



Two Days - Training Workshop on Disaster Management, Marora, Dist-Nuh, Haryana 13th - 14th February 2021. 45 Participants got Trained in this workshop. The workshop includes the Sessions of the lectures & Activities by various experts from the field of Disaster Management. Mr. Suresh (Civil Defence) Conduct the program on what is a disaster? What is Disaster Management and he also gives Fire Fighting Training, Mr. Amir Jamal (Volunteer Coordinator) gives a lecture on the Qualities and Responsibilities of volunteers, Mr. Irfan Ahmad (National Coordinator, SBF) organized Team Building Activities (Goal setting training). Mr. Zahid Afzal (PR Executive) Give a Presentation on PR and Social Media. In the Concluding session, Mr. Wakeel Ahmad (SDM, Hathin, Haryana) was a Chief Guest, Mr. Muazzam Ahmad Naik, (Secretary SBF), Mr. Shibli Arsalan (Director, Al-Jamia Campus Mewat), Jb. Asif Iqbal and Zahid Husain (Halqa Representatives) were also resource person.

National Advance Training Workshop

Society for Bright future has organised. Training of disaster management adventure Techniques, in camp wild, Haryana, from 22nd March, 2021 to 26th March 2021. With training team Mr. T Arif Ali, Chairman HWT, Mr. Suresh Kumar Directorate of civil defence Delhi, Mr. Shariq & Mr. Zahid Afzal, Jb. S Ameen-ul-hasan Senior NLP Trainer, Mr. Usman Instructor mountaineering, Mr. Atiq-ur-Rahman Assistant Senior Human Resource Developer, Mr. Salman Ahmad SIO National president, Mr. Matiur Rahman Psychologists, listening community. Shafi Madni, Treasure SBF.

It was a 5 days training happened as:- On Day 1 after opening ceremony Mr. T Arif Ali explained the Qualities and responsibilities of a volunteer. Later on Mr. Suresh kumar began training session on Disaster and disaster management and First aid (both theoretical and physical knowledge over different types of fire and how they



can extinguish through different methods). Day 2 second day was start with yoga then Mr. Usman the instructor Adventure Technique with his team of 5 members Gave training to SBF's volunteer of Tracking, Bouldering, Free and artificial Rock Climbing (When its not safe to go through the road then volunteers must know the other way and that is mountain climbing you can get out by climbing on a large rocks and huge mountains) also River Crossing training happened on the same day as (In case of flood when roads and land is blocked due to flood water so volunteers can pass the distance by river crossing technique) including Survival Skill in jungle lecture given by Mr. Shoaib. Day 3 begins with Mr. Usman's training on improvised raft making, rescue training during flood and surprise aliment spider web team building activities and techniques of leadership. Day 4 Mr. Suresh trained what is fire, causes of fire, Type of Fire and various types of extinguishing, mock drill practice and project execution techniques and lecture by Mr. Matiur Rahman in Psychotherapy for disaster affected and counselling for trauma affected. Later, an organizational meet was held with Mr. Nusrat Ali. DAY 5 Briefing on coordination strategy with SBF volunteers, past experience of Rescue & Relief Activities by Mr. Shafi Madni than Mass crematorium of Hindu, Muslim, and Christian. After that SBF signing off the training with closing ceremony and headed to delhi.
