## RESPONSE TO EMERGENCY



**ASSAM FLOOD**



In the month of May, the Flood in Assam affected 55+ Lakhs people in 33 districts and claimed the lives of 139 people. According to the Assam State Disaster Management Authority, more than 3 Lakh people, including pregnant women and children shifted in relief camps. 236 SBF Volunteers had involved in rescue and relief activities at 16 places of 10 Districts.
