## EASTERN UP FLOOD



In October 2022, heavy rainfall caused floods in Balarampur, in the Eastern Uttar Pradesh. Over 1300 villages were affected by this flood. A five-volunteer team from Banaras and Mr. Amir Jamal from Headquarter Delhi Reached Balarampur District for rescue and relief supervision.



### MEDICAL RELIEF CAMP

Society for Bright Future organized Medical Relief Camp in the supervision of national coordinator Mr. Irfan Ahmad and SBF volunteers in Utraula & Balrampur, UP more than 850 people benefitted from Medical Relief Camp.



### **BRIDGE INCIDENT** MORBI, GUJARAT

A dreadful bridge Collapse incident took place in Morbi, Gujarat in which at least 135 people died and many were wounded.

The SBF Gujarat team reached the incident site and met the families of those who lost their loved ones. The team also met with the local people who rescued the 120+ people from the river and appreciated their efforts.



### **SLUM FIRE** BHALASWA GAUN, DELHI

35 Shanties were completely destroyed by fire in Bhalaswa Gaun, Delhi. Almost 150 to 200 People affected. Though there was no loss of life or any human injury, they lost their all belongings and material owned by them.

Society for Bright Future (SBF) Delhi Co-Convener Mr. Umrul Hassan and Volunteer Mr. Rizak Mohammad conducted survey and discussions with affected people. The SBF was the first to visit there and responded.

## **BLOOD DONATION CAMP**



On the occasion of World Blood Donation Day, Society for Bright Future (SBF) organized blood donation camps in Howrah, West Bangal. 40 units of blood were collected in this camp.

## **PLANTATION** CAMP

SBF Volunteers organized plantation drive in Unhel, Madhya Pradesh to play an essential role in making this world a better place for current and future generations. Multiple saplings were replaced by volunteers.

# **TRAINING & WORKSHOP**

### **STATE TRAINING WORKSHOPS**

In the Month October, two-day training workshop on Disaster Management was organized at Barpeta, Assam and Nanital, Uttarakhand for 5 State i.e. Assam North, Assam South, UP East, UP West and Uttarkhand where 120 volunteers were trained in First Aid, CPR, Fire Fighting, River Crossing, Rescue etc.

At the end of the workshop, awards and certificates were distributed to the participants.





## **DISTRICT TRAINING** WORKSHOPS

A training workshop on Disaster Management was organized by Society for Bright Future (SBF) in Jehtana Mewat (Nuh), Haryana where 30 volunteers trained in First Aid, CPR, Fire Fighting, Stretcher Making, River Crossing, Rescue etc. The main objective of organizing this training programme was to prepare the volunteers to respond during any calamity whether manmade or natural in their areas and across the country.

Society for Bright Future organised The "Capacity Building Workshop" for Area Core Conveners of Assam, at Howly Dist. Barpeta, Assam, Training Provided on Resource mobilization, project management, and collaboration with disaster management agencies.

In this regard SBF took a new Initiative "Kapda Bank" to provide New and old Clothes to needy people. 



### **BLANKET** DISTRIBUTION
