Emergency Relief: Fire Tragedies

Bihar, Delhi, West Bengal:

SBF acted swiftly across several fire-hit areas:

- Jhamta Village (Araria, Bihar) Ration kits provided to 40 families affected on April 7.
- Rohini Sector 17 (Delhi) After 800+ shanties were destroyed and two children lost their lives, the SBF Delhi team led by Dr. Amir Jamal supported the grieving families and initiated long-term assistance planning.
- Rituraj Hotel Fire (Kolkata) 15 lives lost; SBF, under Wasim Akram, extended comfort and support.
- Araria Sadar Hospital Fire (Bihar) On May 8, a medical storage unit fire prompted immediate evacuation by the SBF team led by Tausif Alam, who was praised by the District Magistrate.
- Kaliachak (Malda, West Bengal) 30 families rendered homeless; the Malda Core Team provided food and support.

Building Collapse in Mustafabad, Delhi

In the early hours of April 19, a building collapsed in Mustafabad. SBF Delhi, under Dr. Amir Jamal, visited GTB Hospital, assessed needs, and offered rehabilitation to affected families.



Flood Relief & Rescue Operations – Assam

In response to the devastating floods that struck parts of Assam in late May 2025, Society for Bright Future (SBF) launched timely and coordinated relief efforts across multiple affected areas.

On 31st May, during the flash floods in Guwahati, SBF volunteers actively joined hands with Assam Civil Defence to carry out joint rescue operations, providing critical assistance to stranded families.

In Karimganj (Notungram & Sribhumi), our team collaborated with State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) to rescue 60 people from rising waters. In Tukergram, volunteers extended immediate aid, rescuing residents as well as stranded animals.



Thanks to the unwavering dedication of the SBF Assam team, more than 2,000 individuals and 500 animals were rescued and brought to safety across the region. The operation stood as a testament to the power of collective action and the spirit of humanity in times of crisis.











Medical Relief Camp

Following the extensive flood rescue operations in Assam, Society for Bright Future (SBF) organized a Medical Relief Camp in Tukergram to support the health and recovery of flood-affected families.

With the help of local doctors and dedicated SBF volunteers, the camp provided essential healthcare services and free medicines to over 350 flood victims, addressing <u>immediate concerns such as waterborne diseases</u>, infections, and post-disaster trauma.

This timely intervention not only offered medical aid but also reassurance and dignity to the affected communities—reinforcing SBF's ongoing commitment to long-term relief and recovery efforts.

World Environment Day Tree Plantation Drives

SBF celebrated the day with green drives:

- Guwahati Zone: 6 varieties planted at Hatigaon High School.
- Kolkata Zone: 830 saplings across 9 sites.
- Dhubri Zone: 170 saplings across 7 areas with 30+ volunteers under Mr. Fatek Ali's leadership.

Blood Donation Drive

- Society for Bright Future organized a Health & Emergency Awareness Program at Boalia Government Polytechnic College, Uluberia (Howrah), with strong support from local teams.
- The event saw the active participation of 30 enthusiastic volunteers, promoting community health, hygiene, and disaster preparedness among students and residents.







Traffic Rule Awareness at Agra Zone

To encourage road safety and responsible behavior, the Society for Bright Future's Agra Zone Rule conducted a Traffic Awareness Program in the Karhal Area Core. The session was led by Zonal Convener Mr. Qasim Jaan and Area Convener Mr. Israr, with active participation over 30 community members, including youth and local residents.



Jal Rahat Shivir Summer Heatwaye Relief

To help communities cope with the intense summer temperatures, Society for Bright Future organized water distribution camps across multiple zones, bringing relief to thousands in need.

• In Farukhabad (Agra Zone), over 1,500 individuals benefitted from the initiative.

- Burhana (Meerut Zone) witnessed the distribution of clean drinking water to more than 3,000 people.
- In Hathigaon (Guwahati Zone), two camps served over 3,500 beneficiaries, ensuring hydration and care during peak heat conditions.

Khushiyon Ke Libas

From April to June 2025, Society for Bright Future (SBF) carried out its nationwide campaign Khushiyon Ke Libas, distributing over 5,000 clothes across 10+ states including Assam, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Punjab, and Delhi. The campaign was officially launched on 4th May in Guwahati, followed by major events in cities like Karimganj, Jabalpur, Agra, Budaun, and Malerkotla. A special poster and brochure unveiling ceremony at the national office, along with a Pan-India Virtual Launch, marked the beginning of this mission to serve the underprivileged with dignity.







With the support of 200+ volunteers, 12 awareness events, and collaboration with local NGOs and institutions, the campaign brought warmth and joy to thousands of families. The commitment of Mr. Shafi Madni, Mr. Irfan Ahmad, Dr. Amir Jamal, and the state/zonal teams played a key role in the campaign's success, turning this initiative into a nationwide expression of compassion and care.

Khushiyon Ke LibasClothing Drive

During the months of April to June 2025, Society for Bright Future (SBF) continued its mission of compassion through the Khushiyon Ke Libas campaign, spreading festive cheer by distributing 1,680 new garments to 840 underprivileged families across six regions. Each family received two sets of clothing, enabling them to celebrate special moments with dignity and pride.

The distribution was carried out in Howrah (400 families), Agra (130), Muradnagar (150), Punjab (50), Jharkhand (40), and Delhi (61), thanks to the dedicated efforts of our state teams and volunteers. This initiative once again reflected SBF's unwavering commitment to uplift and serve marginalized communities through meaningful, people-centered campaigns.

Shramdaan for a Cleaner Tomorrow – Agra Zone

Demonstrating their commitment to environmental responsibility and civic duty, SBF volunteers from the HQSO Agra Zone organized a meaningful Shramdaan (Cleanliness Drive) in the Kuraoli Area Core.

With unwavering dedication, a group of six volunteers rolled up their sleeves to clean neglected roadside areas, collecting waste and restoring cleanliness to the surroundings. This hands-on effort not only beautified the locality but also encouraged the community to take pride in maintaining public hygiene.

Through such selfless acts of service, SBF continues to inspire individuals to become active participants in building cleaner, healthier neighborhoods—one step, one street at a time.
