Emergency Relief & Rehabilitation

Flood Response

In October, SBF volunteers actively responded to floods in Bihar, West Bengal, and Assam (North), covering 8 districts. They rescued 5,240 people and provided relief to over 600 families, including ready-to-eat food for 250 families and medical aid for 350 families.



FRERELIEF

Fire Response

On November 19, 2024, a devastating fire broke out in the Bawana area of New Delhi, impacting numerous families. As always, the Society for a Bright Future (SBF) stood strong as first responders. On November 27, 2024, SBF, in collaboration with partner organization, distributed 1 blanket, 1 small gas cylinder, and one mattress to 210 families.

FLOOD PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM




















TRAINING & WORKSHOPS

TRAINING WORKSHOP DISASTER REDUCTION AND RESILIENCE

- Hyderabad (Oct 12-13): 56
 volunteers trained in disaster
 response, first aid, and resilience
 through expert sessions and
 practical exercises.
- Howrah (Dec 25-26): 70
 volunteers from 8 districts
 received hands-on training in first
 aid, civil defense, and firefighting,
 guided by NDRF and fire brigade
 officials.

FLOOD MITIGATION TRAINING

- Patna (Oct 27): Focused on Bihar's flood risks, with over 50 volunteers gaining insights on collaboration with government agencies and disaster readiness.
- Delhi (Nov 3): 35 volunteers trained in CPR, rescue techniques, and teamwork by expert trainers.





COLLABORATION WITH GOVT AGENCIES

- In December 2024, the Society for Bright Future (SBF) actively participated in pivotal disaster response and development initiatives across Assam.
- SBF participated in disaster response meetings, mock drills, and training sessions in Assam, collaborating with DDMA, SDRF, police, and other agencies to enhance preparedness.





PUBLIC UTILITY PROGRAMS

- Tree for Life: Over 750 saplings planted across Bihar and Assam to mark International Disaster Risk Reduction Day.
- Blood Donation: 12 units collected during a drive in Jharkhand led by young SBF volunteers.
- Health Camps: General health camps benefited 880+ individuals in Assam, West Bengal, and Jharkhand.

AWARENESS PROGRAMS:

- Earthquake Preparedness: Conducted in 9 districts with 685 participants.
- Traffic Rules: Reached 1,140 participants in Assam.
- De-Addiction: Educated 60 students in Goalpara, Assam.
- Cleanliness: Swachhta campaigns and wall-writing initiatives promoted awareness in Kamrup, Assam.


















PROJECT RAHAT (WINTER RELIEF)
